Dr. Egidijus Mardosas is Lecturer of Ancient and Contemporary Political Theory at Mykolas Romeris University (Vilnius), a Research Fellow at the Centre for Aristotelian Studies and Critical Theory at Mykolas Romeris University, and a post-doctoral Research Fellow at the Institute of Philosophy, Vilnius University. His main research interests are contemporary Marxist critique, Aristotelian ethics and politics, and Critical theory. In 2017 Dr. Mardosas defended his PhD thesis entitled *Alasdair MacIntyre's Revolutionary Aristotelianism: Politics of Emancipation, Community and the Good* (Vytautas Magnus University, Kaunas). He continues his research in the critical potential of neo-Aristotelian social philosophy in his post-doctoral project entitled "Ideology and Practical Reason: a Neo-Aristotelian Approach". He is the author of several scholarly papers on Aristotelianism, Marxism and Critical Theory.
